

The birth of Carlton Cricket Club took place in the unlikeliest of circumstances in 1863 when a local Literary and Debating Society needed a summer pastime. Their discussions led to the formation of Carlton CC, which played its first games at the Meadows, just north of Grange Loan.

In 1879 Carlton was one of the founder members of the Scottish Cricket Union (now CricketScotland). By 1900 the club had an excellent side, with one of its players, George Jupp, dominating the Scottish game. After playing on several fields in the Grange, the club moved to its current home in 1904. Carlton thrived under the leadership of Dr N.L Stevenson for the next 50 years, even playing the Royal Household at Windsor.

Over the years many of Scotland's finest players have worn the Carlton cap, among them the Reverend James Aitchison, Richard Swan (Scotland captain and member of the Carlton double winning side of 1988) and of our current players, Bryn Lockie, Jamie Kerr, Cedric English, Scotland batting star Fraser Watts and women's international Leigh Kasperek.

With a fine side at Grange Loan in 2008 and a blossoming youth setup, perhaps you'll forgive us for thinking that the most exciting chapter in our history has yet to be written.

For the first time the company presented awards to individual players, excluding professionals. There were four awards - for the best batsman, bowler, all-rounder and wicket

The respective individual award winners were Bruce Patterson (Ayr), George Innes (Carlton), Jim Govan (Carlton) and David Haggo (Ayrshire).

The judges consisted of a panel of journalists assisted by Henry Thow, president of the SCU, and Jim Wilson, of the SCU's competitions' committee.

This season sees the 20th anniversary of arguably the club's most successful ever season. In 1988, Carlton won both the East League and the Masterton Trophy, and were crowned the Famous Grouse Team of the Year - a remarkable achievement for an all-amateur side. To make it a year to remember, 1998 was also the 125th anniversary of the club so the celebrations were even sweeter!

To mark the occasion, a team re-union is being held on Saturday 16th August to coincide with the

match against Grange. Along with the local suspects, it is hoped that David Ponniah will return from Sri Lanka, lim Govan from Ireland, and Bob Marsden from England.

No doubt memories will go back to the last game league shoot-out against Kirkcaldy made all the more tense due to the fact that Carlton, although often going close, had never won the East League since its inception 35 years previously. 1988 skipper Hugh Parker well remembers the key moment in the match:

"George Innes bowled the Kirkcaldy professional, Indian Test player Wookeri Raman, with a beautifully flighted delivery. I remember that the roar from the Bar almost brought the roof off the old pavilion!"


